NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Exhibitors, through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of current ASCA rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial, including, but not limited to, the following:

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting any signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.
- Dogs are not required to have an ASCA Registration, ASCA LEP, or ASCA QT Number to enter this trial. However, to receive ASCA titling certificates, refer to the next bullet.
 Handlers do not need to be ASCA members.
- Receipt of ASCA Titling Certificates -
 - For non-ASCA registered dogs In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT Number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a QT Number after ASCA qualifying legs have already been earned. The ASCA Membership and QT Number Application form is included in this premium. For additional membership information, please go to www.asca.org.
- Current jump height table, breed exemption list, description of classes, levels, and divisions can be found at ASCA's web site.
- Agility obstacles will include: slatted rubberized A-Frame and dog walk, slat-less rubberized Teeter, open tunnels, non-winged jumps, winged jumps, double bar jump, displaceable tire and 24" weave poles. A-Frame height will be set to 5'3".
- THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, the ASCA office will be informed of the problem.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No food, toys, other aids or devices will be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the rings at any time.
- No entry shall be accepted from a handler or for a dog disqualified from the ASCA agility program, disqualified from all ASCA programs, or anyone not in good standing with ASCA.

ENTRY FORM / ENTRIES / CONFIRMATIONS:

- Entries will be accepted in the order they are sent, not received. For entries sent via Postal Service, the valid reference date is the postmark. Otherwise the valid date is the ship date.
 Entries with an early postmark will be processed after Day 5 receipts. Unreadable postmarks will be assumed to be the day previous to receipt.
- Entries may be accepted after the closing date if openings are available.
- ASCA Registration/QT Number If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd (either full registration or LEP) or has an ASCA QT Number, write your dog's ASCA registration/LEP number/QT Number in this space.
- If this field is left blank, the ASCA Business Office will assume this dog is not registered with ASCA and will not automatically track qualifying legs. However, these dogs will still be placed and will receive any placement awards offered. You may submit the ASCA QT Form with your entry – HOWEVER please make fees payable to ASCA.
- A dog must compete in the height division in which they have been entered. Exception: when a dog is required by the judge to move to a higher height. These dogs will be placed last in the running order of the new jump height. Dogs measuring up in height may run FEO.
- Canadian Exhibitors: All fees MUST be submitted in US Funds via International Postal Money Order.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and will incur a \$20 service charge.
- Telephone calls returned/initiated with questions on any entries will be made collect.
- JUNIOR HANDLER ENTRY FEES will be one-half of the published fees. The Junior Handler must own or co-own the dog they are showing to be eligible for this entry fee.
- FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) entries will be accepted. Minimum age is 15 months. Any dog younger than 18 months must jump at least 4" lower than regular height. No placements. Non-titling.

SHOW SITE:

- This event will be held indoors on a fully matted ring.
- There is limited room for crating, please stack where possible; no x-pens will be allowed.
- A warm-up area with a single practice jump will be provided for exhibitors.
- ALL dogs must be held on leash or crated except when competing or in the warm-up area.
- Enthusiasts of agility have earned a reputation for being among the most considerate and tidy.
 We thank everyone in advance for upholding the respectful tradition of leaving the trial site and related lodging sites cleaner than we found them.

REFUNDS / WITHDRAWALS:

- There will be no refund/credit for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for a dog's injury and/or illness or for bitches that come into season after the closing date. These entries will be eligible for a refund for the amount of the total entry fee paid less \$20.00. A signed letter from your veterinarian must be included with your written request. Requests must be received by the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial.
- There will be no refunds if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Committee. There will be no refund in the event dog/handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of reason.

FOOD / VENDORS

- Breakfast and lunch will be provided for volunteers by ASCNE.

RULE CHANGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Jumps will not be reset during gamblers. If faulted (zero points awarded), the tire jump may not be re-used for points in the opening sequence. If a jump (including the tire) in the required 'gamble sequence' is used in the opening point accumulation period and the bar/tire is displaced, the 'gamble sequence' will end at that obstacle and no more gamble points will be awarded.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE AND RING ASSIGNMENTS

<u>Saturday</u> – EG1, OG1, NG1, EG2, OG2, NG2, ER1/ER2, OR1/OR2, NR1/NR2, EJ1/EJ2,

OJ1/OJ2, NJ1/NJ2. Run order low to high.

<u>Sunday</u> – ER3/ER4, OR3/OR4, NR3/NR4, EG3, OG3, NG3, EG4, OG4, NG4, EJ3/EJ4, OJ3/OJ4, NJ3/NJ4, Run order low to high.

(E=Elite, O=Open, N=Novice; R=Regular, J=Jumpers, G=Gamblers).

The running order of classes is subject to change at the discretion of the judges and/or the host club. The final order will be included in the confirmation packet.

REGISTRATION / MEASURING

- Saturday and Sunday between 7:15 and 7:45AM
- Dogs with a wither height ≤20" will need to show proof of measurement or be measured at registration, unless the dog is jumping in the highest jump height offered in whatever program they are entering. Copies of ASCA, NADAC or AKC height cards may either be mailed in or presented at registration.

MOVE-UPS:

- Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday will be permitted. Trial Secretary must be notified no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Saturday has finished.

PRIZES / AWARDS

- Green Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs achieving a qualifying score.
- Placement Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs placing 1st through 4th in each class and jump height.
- 20+ and 24 will be scored and placed together as one class.
- Ribbons/prizes must be picked up during the weekend. Ribbons WILL NOT be mailed.

- A dog may be entered in a class at a jump height higher than they are eligible provided the dog is not entered in the Veteran or ACE Senior Division classes.
- No dog shall ever jump lower than 4" in the Junior Handler, Veteran, ACE Standard or ACE Senior Division.
- Refer to the current ASCA rulebook for the current Breed Jump Height Exemption List.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

<u>From Rt 293/101</u> – Take Exit 1-South Willow St/Mall of NH. Go ¾ mile past the Mall, staying in the left lane. At the fork, bear left. At the yellow blinking light, take a left onto Sheffield Rd. All Dogs Gym is ahead on the right.

From the North (Concord) – Take Rt 293/101 and follow the directions for Rt 293/101 above. From the South (Salem, NH) – Take Rt 93 North. Take Exit 5. Go left at the bottom of the exit towards Manchester. Go 3.5 miles to the yellow blinking light (past the Yard Restaurant). At the yellow blinking light take a right onto Sheffield Road. All Dogs Gym is ahead on the right.

Volunteer Sign-Up (...We Really Need Your Support)

As at every event, no club can pull off a trial without the help and support of our exhibitors to keep the agility trial running smoothly and efficiently. **We will not be able to do this without your involvement.** Working in and around the ring is a great way to increase your knowledge and understanding of the sport. If you have a guest or significant other who would be willing to work at the trial, we'd be thrilled! A list of areas where help is needed and their associated description is below.

We appreciate your help and will do what we can for your comfort, including the volunteers' refreshment area for trial workers and helpers.

This year we will have a volunteer sign-up board available each morning of the trial.

Thank you for volunteering and making this a better show for everyone. We couldn't do it without you!

Below are descriptions of the different areas where volunteers are needed throughout the trial

(Starred (**) jobs are for rank novices – little training required!!)

Timer (1 per ring)

- Restriction Cannot be changed during the course of a class
- Tells handler when to begin
- Monitors that the electronic timer starts and ends; reads time to scribe
- For Gamblers, need to start the timer for each run and may need to stop

Scribe (1 per ring)

- Verifies scribe sheet is for the dog that has entered the ring
- Records on the scribe sheet all penalties signaled by the judge and the run time and gives the scribe sheet to the score runner

Gate Steward (1 per ring)

- Maintains a constant and orderly flow of exhibitors into the ring by keeping three (3) exhibitors ready to go at all times
- Communicates any change in run order to the scribe
- Informs ring stewards when it's time to change the jump heights
- Need to be assertive, have good organization skills, and knowledge of ring procedure helps to know exhibitors

**Ring Steward (2-4 per ring)

 Quickly sets each jump for each class/jump height level, straightens the chute on the collapsed tunnel after every dog, replaces poles on jumps during or immediately following each dog's run

**Leash Runner (1 per ring)

Brings leashes from start line to finish line

**Score Runner (1 per ring)

- Brings scribe sheets from the scribe to the scorekeeper

Scoring (1 per ring)

- Enter information on scribe sheet into the computer
- For Gamblers, a second person is helpful to total the number of obstacles taken during the opening time period
- Print completed results at the end of each class and put into score books

AGREEMENT

- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner is knowledgeable of and agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA governing sanctioned agility trials, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA (including ASCA officers, directors, employees, and members), the Australian Shepherd Club of New England (including its officers, directors, members, agents, employees and event organizing committee), All Dogs Gym (including its officers, directors, members, owners, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, event, or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my(our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be or alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

ASCA'S COMMUNICABLE DISEASE POLICY (excerpt):

Refer to ASCA Agility Rules Section 1.3.7 Communicable Disease for full text of policy. "No dog shall be eligible to compete at any show, no dog shall be brought into the grounds or premises of any dog show, and any dog which may have been brought into the grounds or premises of a dog show shall immediately be removed, if it; 1. shows clinical symptoms of canine influenza, distemper, infectious hepatitis, parvovirus, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease, or 2. has been confirmed by a veterinarian to have a communicable disease within thirty days prior to the opening of the show, or 3. has been kenneled within thirty days prior to the opening of the show in a household in which there were veterinarian-confirmed cases of canine influenza, distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease."
